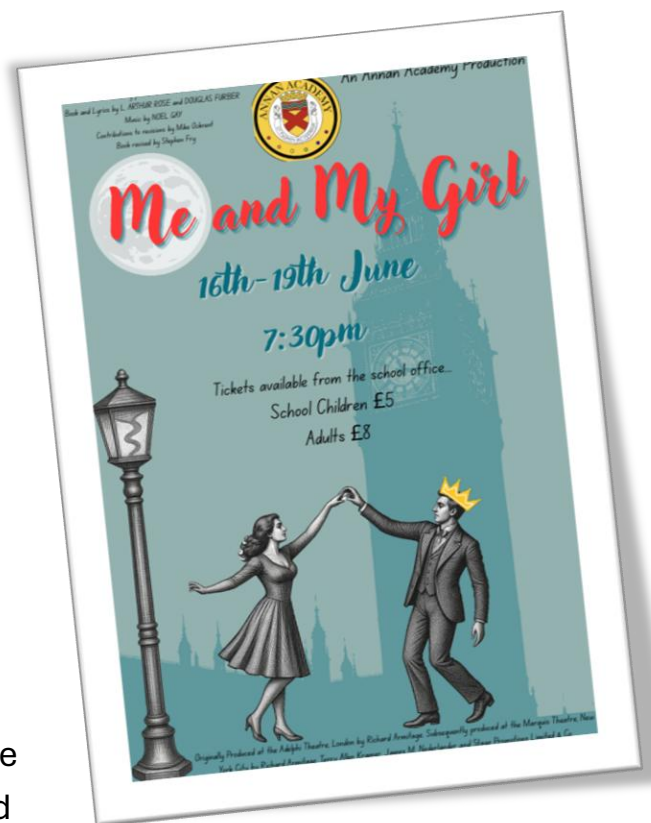
LOCKARD'S LUNCH is today! For those who have booked only...otherwise places cannot be guaranteed.
